Dean College does not offer fully funded scholarships or need based aid to international students. If you are offered admission and become an enrolled student, as part of your Enrollment Checklist, you will be required to submit official supporting financial documentation certifying that you have sufficient funds available to cover expenses for one year of study at Dean College. The approximate cost for the 2026-2027 academic year, once all eligible scholarships have been applied, is \$40,000 USD. Dean provides generous merit scholarships of up to \$32,000 per year, based upon academics and residency status.

Acceptable Financial Document:

- Issued by a financial institution verifying access to funds
- Dated less than 6 months from the entry term
- Officially translated into English
- Funds shown \$ US Dollars
- If sponsored by a government or other sponsoring agency; a signed copy of the scholarship letter stating the amount, name of recipient and duration of the award

You may also be asked to provide the above supporting financial documents during your scheduled Student Visa appointment at your Embassy or Consulate.

Types of financial documents NOT accepted include:

- Annual salary statements, pay stubs, credit card statements
- Real estate holdings
- Investments, stocks, insurance policies, or other accounts from which money cannot be withdrawn
