## Limits on the number of dance technique courses students can enroll in.

There is a limit on the number of dance technique (DAN) courses each student may register for during the initial registration period.

- DAN students (AA, BA, BFA) → 4 courses
- THA BFA (Acting & Musical Theatre) students → 2 courses
- THA BA students and DAN minors → 1 course
- All other Dean Students → 1 course

This process is being implemented to ensure:

- **Equity in access** — allowing all students the opportunity to register for required & level-appropriate technique classes.
- **Student well-being** — maintaining healthy, sustainable training loads that support your growth and safety.

If you wish to enroll in additional technique courses beyond the initial limit, you will need to schedule a brief meeting with **Professor Todd Shanks, Program Coordinator of Dance**, to discuss your request and the reasoning behind it. Exceptions may be granted based on program requirements, performance obligations, class availability or individual student goals.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we work to create a balanced, fair, and safe registration process for everyone.

## **SPECIAL TOPICS COURSE OFFERINGS (COURSE DESCRIPTIONS)**

### **ARTL 390 01 – Special Topics in Arts Leadership – 1 credit**

**Instructor: Professor Stephen Ursprung**

**Meeting Days & Times: Monday, 2:00 to 3:15 pm**

**Course Description:** This seminar explores emerging and enduring themes in arts leadership through a colloquial-style discussion and collaborative inquiry. Students engage with practitioners and thought leaders from across the arts sector to examine topics such as organizational management, advocacy, community engagement, arts entrepreneurship and cultural equity. The course provides an opportunity for Arts Leadership students to connect with professional mentors and explore the evolving landscape of arts administration and leadership. Corequisite: Arts Leadership majors and minor only, at least Sophomore level or higher.

### **BUS 290 01 – Introduction to AI and AI Tools – 3 credits**

**Instructor: Professor Patricia Casey:**

**Meeting Days & Times:** This is an asynchronous online course.

**Course Description:** “Introduction to AI and AI Tools” thoroughly explores AI’s fundamental principles and applications alongside the myriad tools that facilitate AI development and deployment. Designed for beginners, this course provides the essential knowledge and skills to understand and leverage AI technologies effectively.

### **EXSC 290 01 – Introduction to Weight Training – 3 credits**

**Instructor: TBA**

**Meeting Days & Times: Tuesday/Thursday, 8:00 to 9:15 am**

**Course Description:** This course will assist in the development of skills to promote participation in a weight training program. Students will use universal and free weights to develop strength and muscular endurance. The course covers concepts of form, repetition sequence, and provides a basic understanding of muscular and training techniques.

### **EXSC 394 – Motor Learning (3 cr)**

**Instructor: Professor Coleen Bartlett Taylor**

**Meeting Days & Times: Lecture meets Monday & Wednesday, 11:00 to 11:50 am; Lab meets Fridays, 11:00 to 11:50 am**

**Course Description:** This course is designed to help students learn more about the fundamental processes underlying the learning and performance of all kinds of movements. Students will discover how humans learn skilled actions and how the principles of motor performance and learning can be useful in teaching, coaching, and rehabilitation. Students will complete a semester long project in which they will experience and document the process of teaching/learning an unfamiliar and novel movement skill. It is intended to be appropriate for students in physical education, exercise and sport science, kinesiology, psychology, physical and occupational therapy, and pre-medicine. Prerequisites: BIO 167, BIO 171, BIO 175, or BIO 180. Fulfills a DCA Career Intensive Experience course requirement.

## NEW COURSE OFFERINGS (COURSE DESCRIPTIONS)

Course	Title	Description
COM 385 HIS 385	History of Film	This course acquaints students with the historical evolution of the motion picture from its advent in the late-19th century through the present day. In doing so, it situates the evolution of film and filmmaking in its social, economic, technological, cultural, political, and global contexts. Period films in both feature and documentary formats will be analyzed to demonstrate the reciprocal influences between film and historical developments. This course is cross listed with COM 385/HIS 385. Students may not receive credit for both COM 385 and HIS 385. Prerequisite: junior or senior standing.
PHL 313	Artificial Intelligence Ethics	Artificial Intelligence is quickly becoming a major part of our everyday lives, from Autocorrect to ChatGPT and beyond. But with powerful technology comes major ethical questions. Will AI replace teachers, doctors, lawyers, artists? How does AI affect copyright laws and the way artists are paid for their work? How does AI affect the ongoing climate crisis? Does AI threaten our privacy and security? How might AI perpetuate existing unconscious biases such as racism, sexism, and classism? Can we use AI ethically to improve humanity? This course will explore these questions and more through the history and ethics of Artificial Intelligence, from the 1940s through present day. We will consider a wide range of perspectives, from engineers to artists to philosophers, and put their ideas into practice through AI-related projects. Prerequisite: English 112 and junior or senior standing.

# ONLINE COURSES OFFERINGS

**Online Course Enrollment:** Dean College students may take online courses as part of their degree program. The following online course limits apply. Quarter courses are included in the full-term limits.

**For full-time students:**

- First-year students may enroll in no more than one online course during the fall or spring semesters, not to exceed a total of 4 credits per semester.
- Sophomores, juniors, and seniors, except for students on an F-1 visa, may enroll in up to two online courses during fall or spring semesters, not to exceed a total of 8 credits per semester.
- Full-time students on an F-1 visa may enroll in no more than one online course during the fall, winter, spring, or summer terms, not to exceed a total of 4 credits in any single term.
- Full-time students may take no more than 50% of their total overall degree requirements as online courses.

**For part-time students:**

- Part-time students may enroll in one or more online courses, not to exceed a total of 11 credits in any single term.

The following courses meet **ASYNCHRONOUSLY** online. This means students will be responsible to set their own hours to be working on the course and working in the classroom. Students should plan to log in to their Canvas classroom at least three or more days per week to do classwork.
