# **REGISTRATION DATES AND TIMES FOR WINTER INTERSESSION 2026**

Dates students may begin to register for the Winter Intersession are the same as the spring registration dates:

Date	Group	Credits (completed & currently enrolled)
Tuesday, November 4	GROUP 1	84 +
Thursday, November 6	GROUP 2	54 – 83
Wednesday, November 12	GROUP 3	26 – 53
Friday, November 14	GROUP 4	0 – 25

### Registration times are based on completed credits plus current registered credits.

Winter Intersession courses are available for viewing and registration on the same timeline as courses for the spring semester. Students are required to work directly with their advisor regarding winter intersession courses.

#### Registering & Paying for Winter Intersession Courses

- Students have access to view winter intersession courses in Student Planning and the course booklet available on the Success & Career Advising department page on myDean.
- Students interested in taking a winter intersession course should meet with their advisor during the regularly scheduled registration period to review options and plan their winter intersession courses.
- When a student has decided to take a winter intersession course(s), the advisor works with the student to complete the "Winter Intersession 2026 Student Registration" form.
- To be officially registered for a winter intersession course, payment is required. The tuition for winter session courses is \$430 per credit, plus a \$25 registration fee. Students are responsible for contacting Student Financial Planning for payment. Once a student has paid their balance, they will be registered for their winter intersession course(s) assuming space is available.

# **Winter Intersession Course Offerings**

All Winter Intersession courses are scheduled for 4-weeks, starting on Wednesday, December 17, 2025, and ending on Tuesday, January 13, 2026. All these courses are offered as online asynchronous courses.

The following courses meet <u>ASYNCHRONOUSLY</u> online. This means students will be responsible for setting their own hours to read/view/listen to their course materials, to work on assignments, and to respond to discussion forums in their online classroom. Students should plan to log in to their Canvas classroom at least five or more days per week to do classwork and submit required assignments. These courses are recommended for students who have good time management and organizational skills, and who can self-motivate.
